

These trails are some of the more scenic trails at W. Kerr Scott. They offer a tougher challenge with steeper more technical climbs and turns. The Warrior Creek loop is approximately 12 miles. The Warrior Creek portion of the OVT is approximately 5 miles. Expect to see more development of these trails in the next couple of years. Construction of the Headwaters Loop will be begin in 2010. Rules and regulations governing the use of all land and water on W. Kerr Scott Reservoir are contained in Title 36 – Code of Federal Regulations, copies of which are posted in recreation areas and can be obtained at the Visitor Assistance Center near the dam. These regulations are enforced by the US Army Corps of Engineers Park Rangers. Regulations pertinent to the use of the trails are as follows:

- Park only in designated parking areas
- Use only designated trails
- Bike helmets are highly recommended
- Camping only allowed in designated park campgrounds
- Motorized vehicles prohibited on trails
- Fires are prohibited except in designated areas
- Littering is prohibited
- Hunting is prohibited
- Defacement, damage or alteration of public property is prohibited
